



WELCOME TO GUTHEGA SKI CLUB (GSC)

If this is your first stay with us you may like some assistance in finding us.

From Jindabyne take the Kosciusko Road towards Perisher and turn off to Guthega a short distance past Wilson's Valley. The road goes off to the right and is sign posted. It is just **before Sponnar's Lakeside Inn** (the hotel with the small lake and fountain in front of it on the right hand side of the road on the way to Perisher). This road will take you all the way to the Guthega Ski Centre at the bottom of the chairlift

Once there is snow, the road will be closed from just past the Ski Centre and you will have a short walk up to the lodge.

There is overnight parking at Guthega. It is the car park just below the sealed car park outside the ski centre. ***To be able to park on the mountain is a privilege*** which is not available at any other resort. There are a few rules that we must abide by to keep our parking privileges and we must ask you to also abide by them. Cars must be moved out of the car park for snow clearing when advised and in order to identify cars we ask you to display a "sticker" or "card" on your windscreen showing the lodge at which you are staying and the telephone number for that lodge. These "cards" will be sent to you when you book, and/or will be available at the lodge. Then park your car in the designated overnight parking area; the first parking area below the asphalt parking around the Ski Centre. This is not very big and it would be appreciated by all if you could park with consideration to other guests.

The lodges at Guthega are on the uphill (left hand) side of the road leading uphill past the Ski Centre and GSC is the second to last building on the left hand side of this road (just prior to the hotel). GSC is quite prominently displayed on the front of the lodge - see picture at top of page.

The "main entrance" to the lodge is from the bottom road up some steps (or footprints in the snow). There is a door bell at this entrance, or if you have the combination for the lock please enter. You enter via the ski room. Please leave your skis and boots at this level and proceed up the stairs to the lounge area. There is a notice board in the lounge area and a room list will be posted on this notice board. If there is not a current room list, please ask one of the members present to assist you.

In any case please make yourself known to any members/guests who may be in the lodge at the time and they will assist you in room allocation and advising you of where to store food etc.

As you will be aware GSC is a private club with limited membership. It is not a commercial lodge. During your stay you are considered an associate member.

The club does not employ staff and members/associate members are rostered for duties. The duty roster will be placed on the notice board at mid-week and at the weekend. Please check the notice board and complete any duty allocated to you, prior to leaving. If there is no duty list please check with the "party leader" or one of the members.

Just a quick reminder that you do need to bring your own food and linen, i.e. sheets, sleeping bag/doona, and pillowcase. Pillows are supplied.

Cooking facilities at the lodge consist of hot plates, fry pans and a microwave. You may of course choose to eat some of your meals at the hotel which is located immediately adjacent to the lodge. The lodge supplies coffee, tea, sugar, salt and pepper. If you notice that one of these is running out, please notify the party leader.

There is a list of "DO's and DON'Ts" and it would be much appreciated if you would observe them while you are staying with us :

PLEASE DO

- bring your own food and bed linen /doona/sleeping bag
- on arrival, make yourself known at the lodge, to ensure you know the parking procedure and room allocation, food storage procedure, etc.
- write your name on whatever you put in the fridge
- place your non-perishable food in the kitchen cupboards and perishables in the fridge
- eat food in the dining room only, not in the lounge room or bed rooms
- wash and dry your own dishes and utensils A.S.A.P. after your meal and clean the cooking and preparation area you used
- remove dry clothing from the drying room A.S.A.P.
- the lodge is a smoke free zone.

PLEASE DO NOT

- wear ski boots in the lodge other than in the ski room
- leave your gear lying around the lodge
- keep perishables in your room or locker
- bring pets into the lodge (pets are, by legislation excluded from the Kosciusko National Park)
- allow non-residents access to the lodge without first contacting the party leader
- smoke in the lodge

A public telephone is available in the hotel next door, which also provides a restaurant service and bar facilities.

We wish you a pleasant stay and good snow conditions.
